

Figure 1(a): Percentage of source of cigarette among current cigarette smokers secondary school adolescents participated in NHMS: AHS 2022

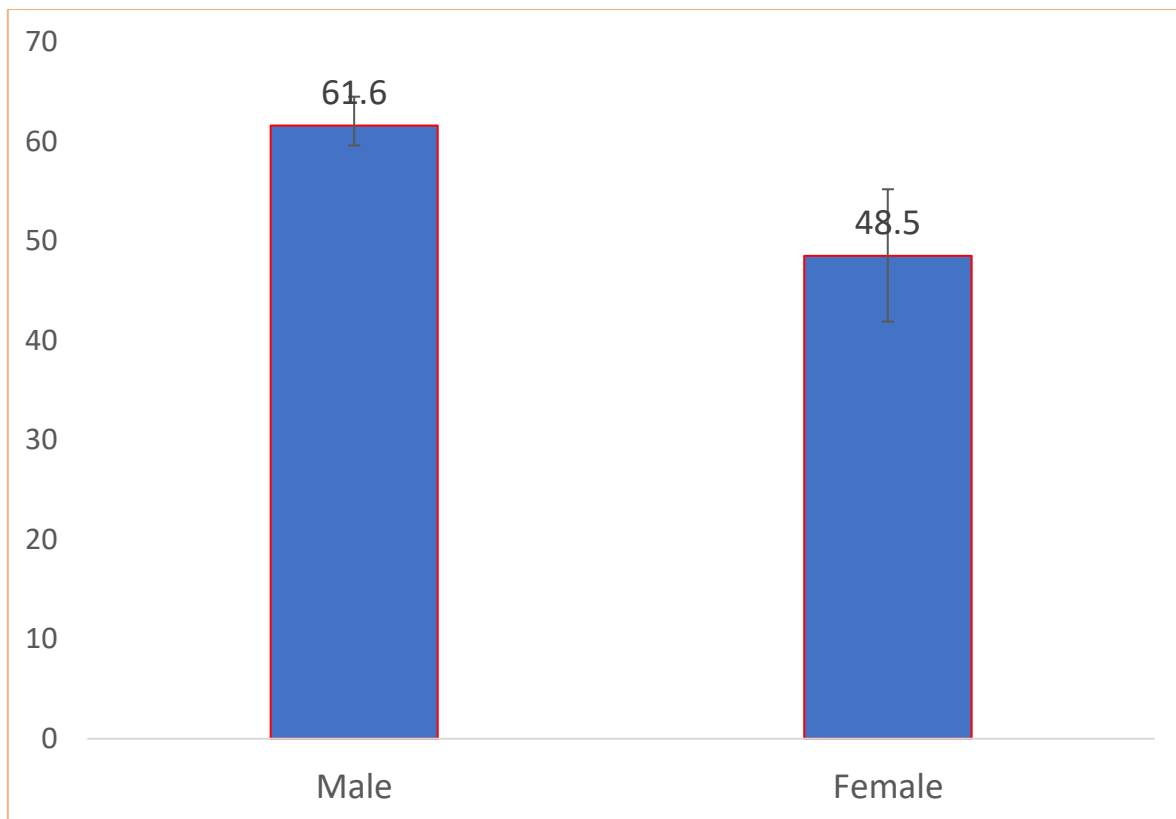


Figure 2(a): Percentage of current cigarette smoker obtained the cigarette from the commercial source by gender among secondary school-going adolescents who participated in the NHMS: AHS 2022

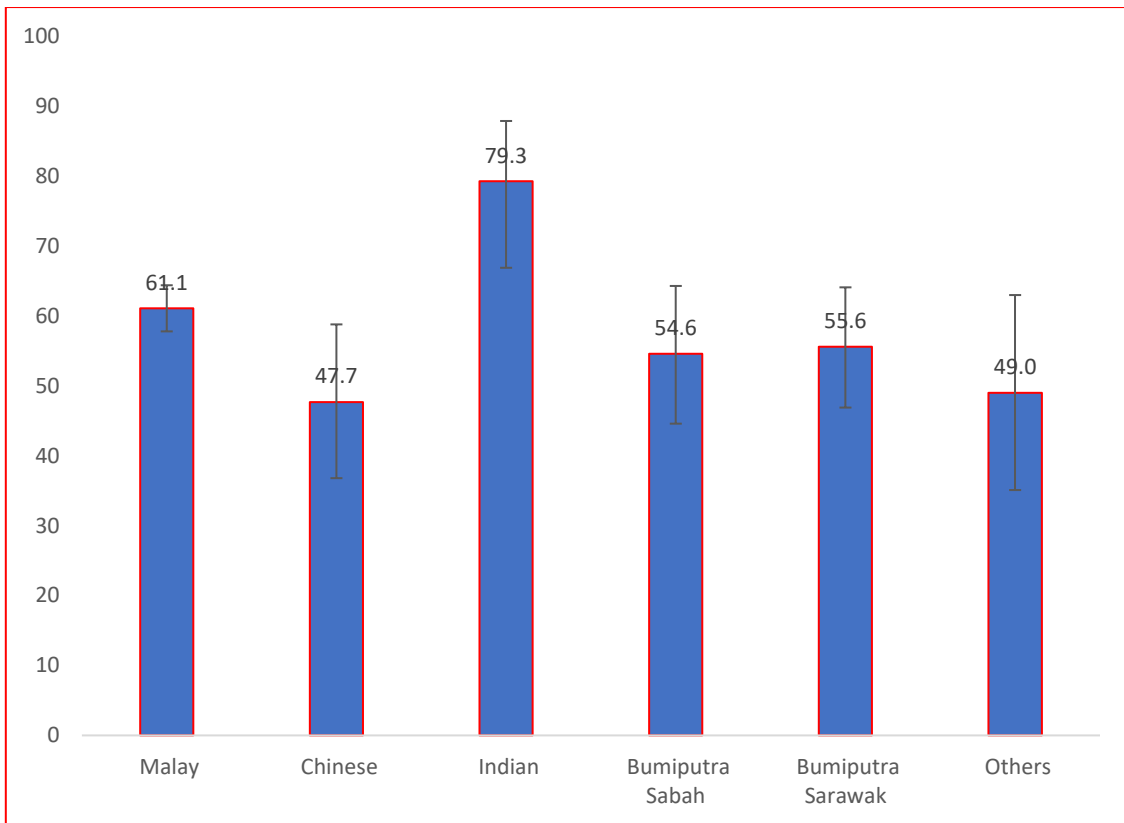


Figure 2(b): Percentage of current cigarette smoker obtained the cigarette from the commercial source by ethnicity among secondary school-going participated in the NHMS: AHS 2022 study

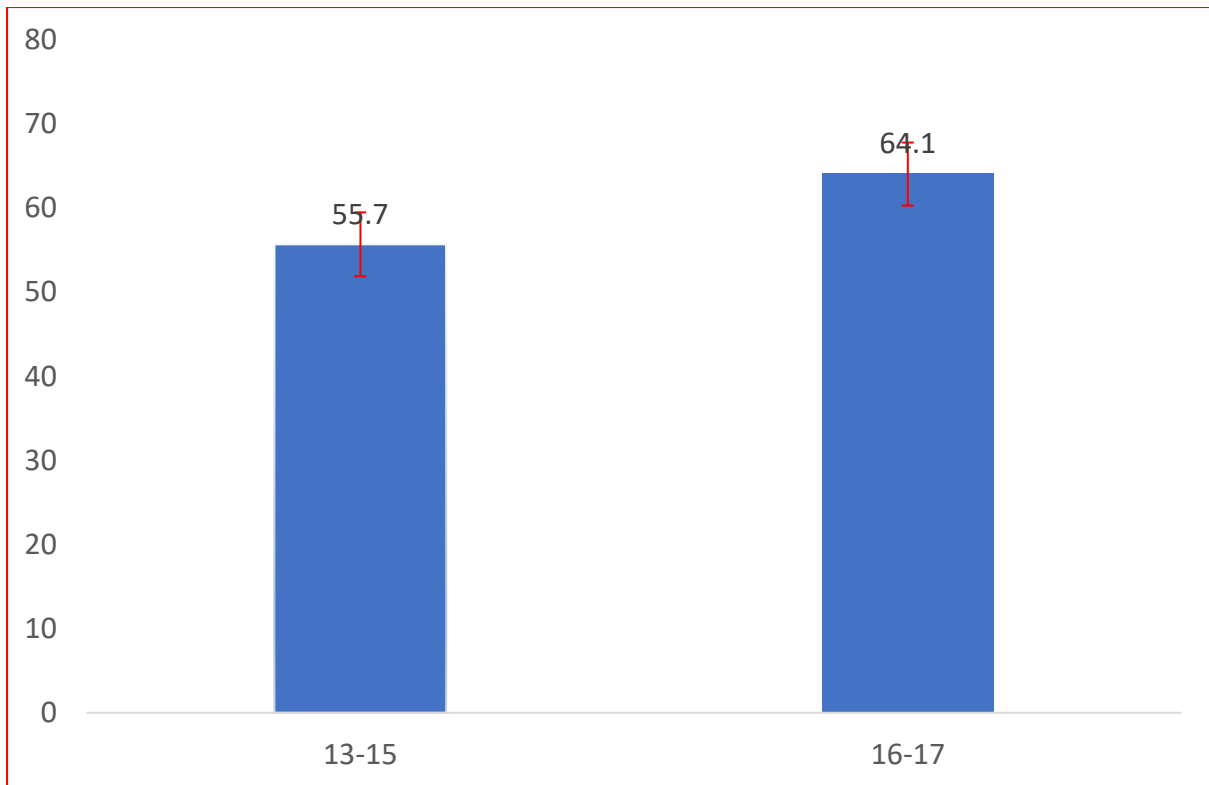


Figure 2(c): Percentage of current cigarette smoker obtained the cigarette from the commercial source by age-groups among secondary school-going participated in the NHMS: AHS 2022 study

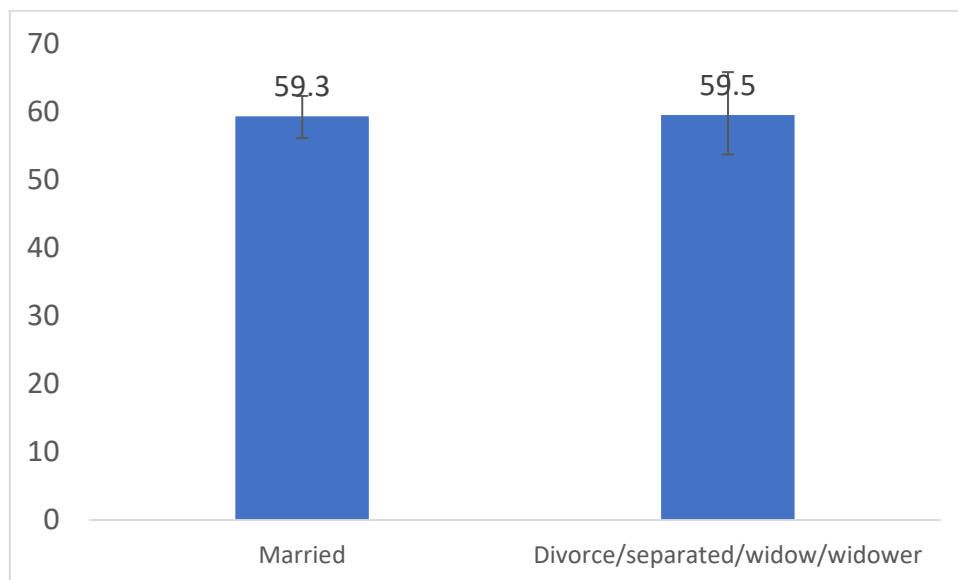


Figure 2(d): Percentage of current cigarette smoker obtained the cigarette from the commercial source by parental marital status among secondary school-going participated in the NHMS: AHS 2022 study

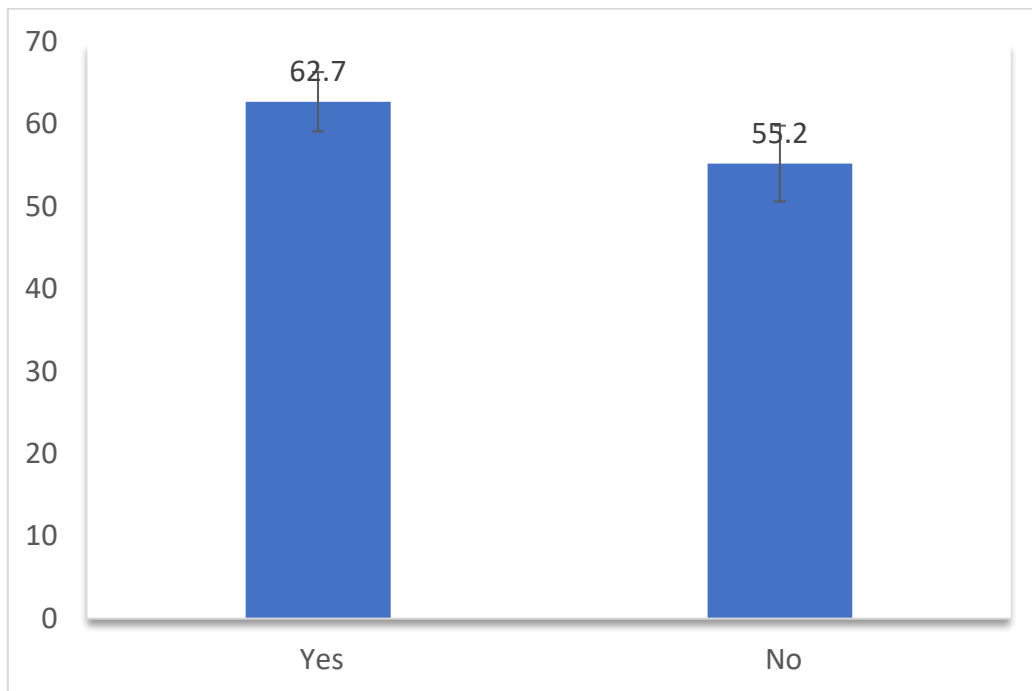


Figure 2(e): Percentage of current cigarette smoker obtained the cigarette from the commercial source by parental smoking status among secondary school-going participated in the NHMS: AHS 2022 study

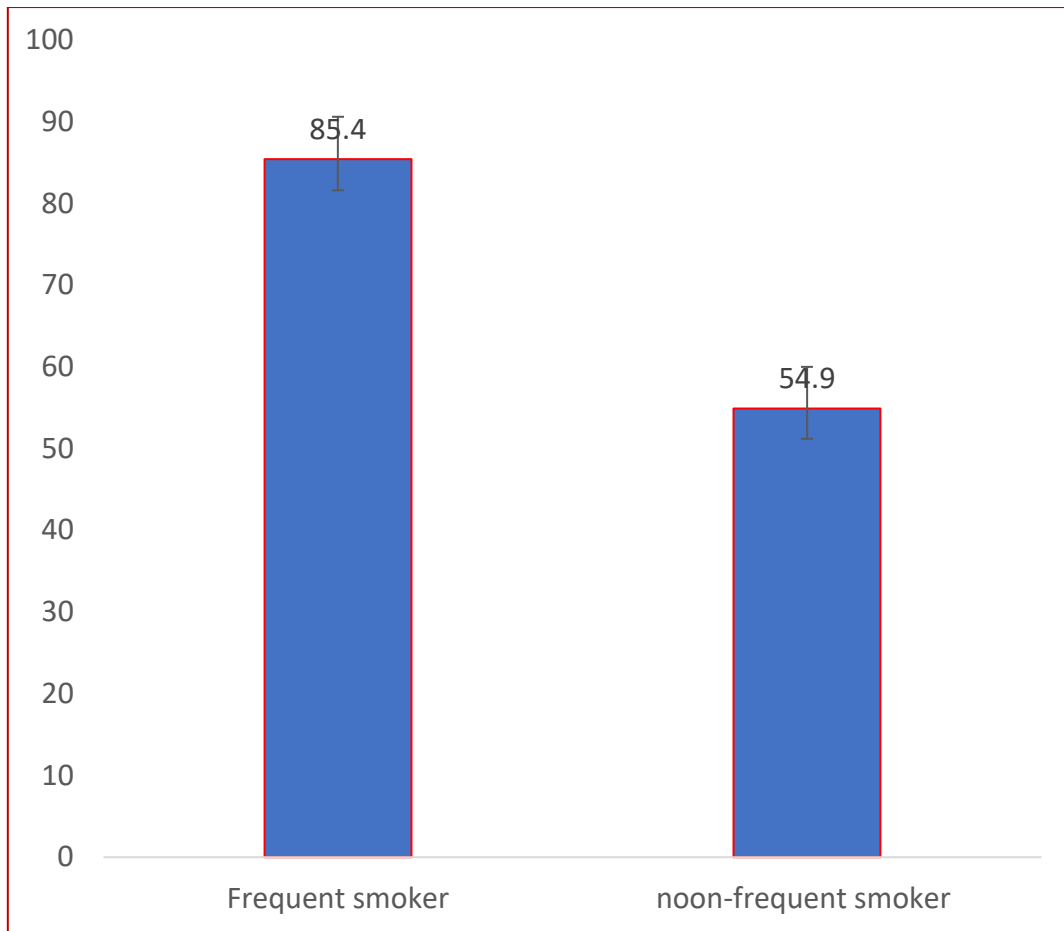


Figure 2(f): Percentage of current cigarette smoker obtained the cigarette from the commercial source by frequent smoker status among secondary school-going participated in the NHMS: AHS 2022 study

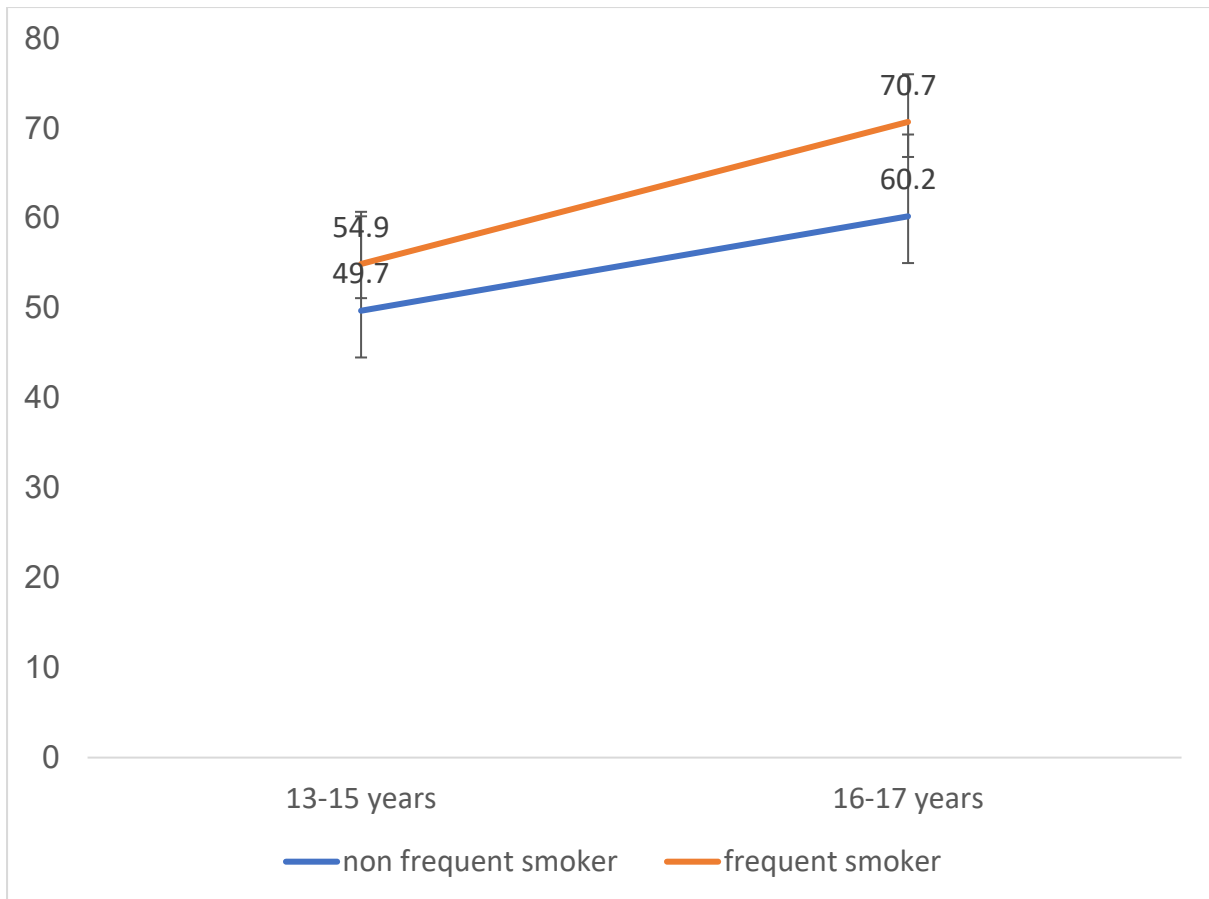


Figure 3: Interaction between age-group and frequent smoking status among current cigarette smoker who participated in NHMS: AHS 2022 study.
